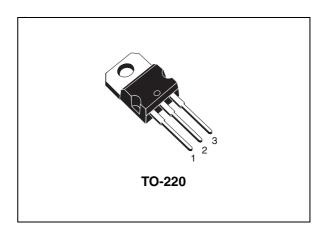


Figure 1. Internal schematic diagram

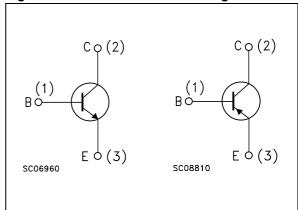

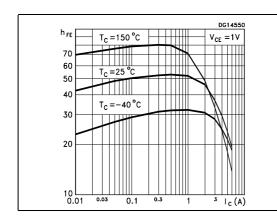

Figure 3. DC current gain (PNP)



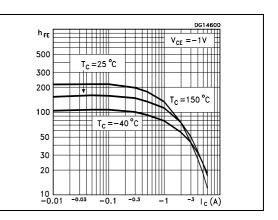
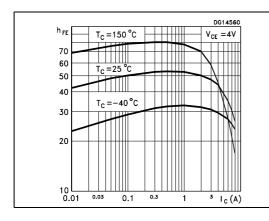


Figure 4. DC current gain (NPN)

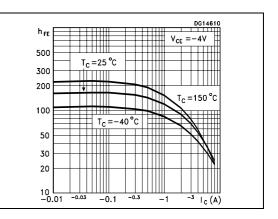
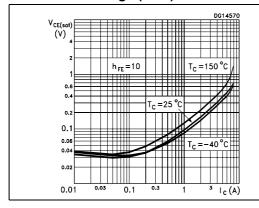
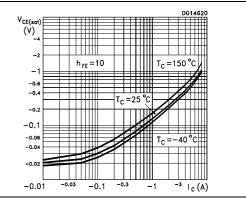


Figure 6. Collector-emitter saturation voltage (NPN)

Figure 9. Base-emitter saturation voltage (PNP)

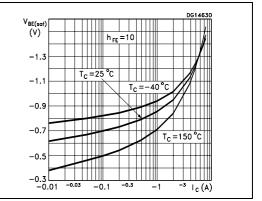
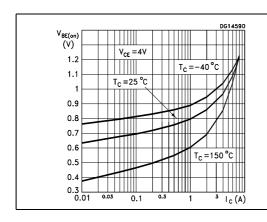


Figure 10. Base-emitter voltage (NPN)

Figure 11. Base-emitter voltage (PNP)



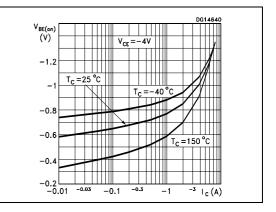
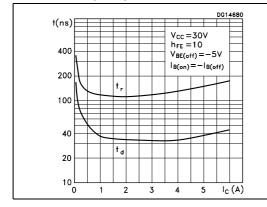
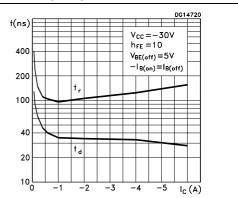


Figure 12. Resistive load switching time Figure 13. Resistive load switching time (NPN) (PNP)

Figure 14. Resistive load switching time Figure 15. Resistive load switching time (NPN) (PNP)

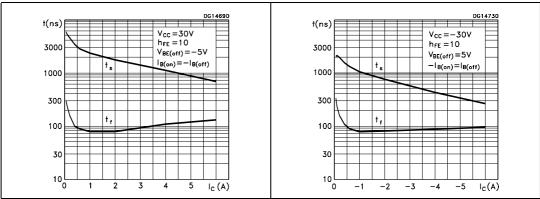
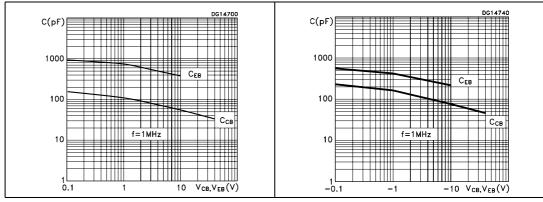


Figure 16. Collector-base and collector- Figure 17. Collector-base and collector- emitter capacitance (NPN) emitter capacitance (PNP)

Figure 18. Inductive load switching test circuit

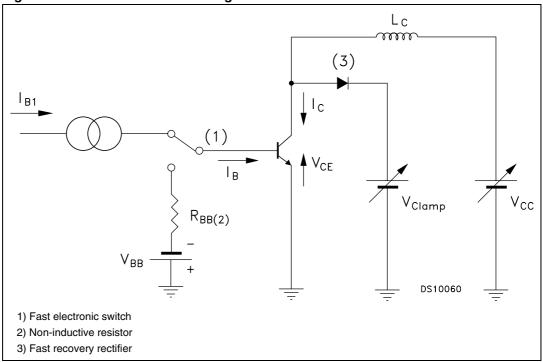
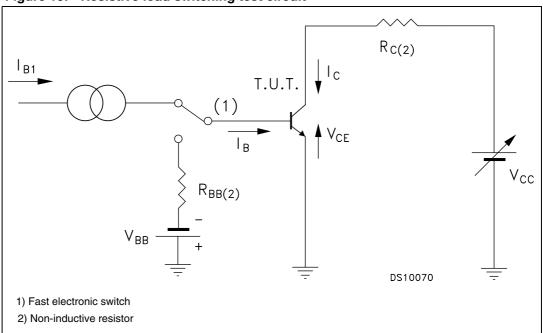


Figure 19. Resistive load switching test circuit



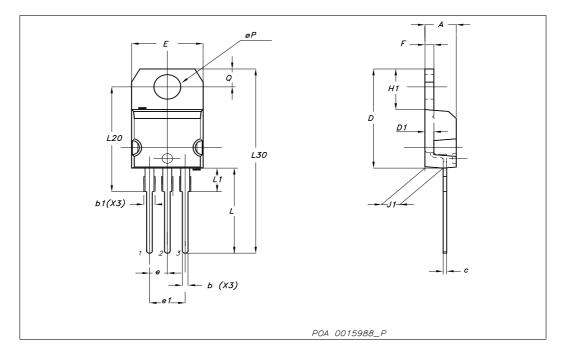
